Toronto Eastern Ry.—Press reports, Sept. 17, stated that engineers had nearly completed surveys for the first section of this projected railway, and that the first section to be built would be from Toronto to Newcastle, Ont. The route will be on a private right of way just north of the Kingston road, nearly all the way. The reports further state that a considerable part of the right of way has been secured, and that contracts for grading, etc., will be let at an early date.
