Three Men Killed by Engine,

Terrible Accident at Kaladar.

Light Engine Strikes Handcar of Section Men.

A terrible accident occurred at Kaladar, about 18 miles cast of Tweed, on Tweeday afternoon about 3 o'clock, when a light engine in charge of Mr. A. Connors of town, struck a handcar on which were four section men. Three of the men were killed outright and the fourth escaped by jumping.

The dead men are Alex. Fleming, section foreman of Kaladar; John Anderson, son-in law of Fleming, of Kaladar; and James Woodcock of Tweed. All three men were married men and leave families.

There is a sharp curve at the scene of the accident and the engine awept upon the handcar without being noticed by the unfortunate men. Havelock Standard
