Ten injured in wreck in Quebec

Through CPR express crashed into work train near Foster.

Ten persons were injured, one of them seriously, when a CPR through passenger train from St. John NB to this city, crashed head-on into a work train on the CPR tracks, two miles east of Foster, Quebec at 10.12 o'clock yesterday morning.

The victims include six passengers, the engineer, who was seriously hurt, and the cook on the passenger train, together with two men on the work train. The engineer of the latter leapt clear of the smash and escaped without a scratch. The most seriously injured victim is W. Rutherford, engineer of the passenger train, who suffered a broken hip, broken ribs, and cuts about the head.
