Dixville, January 22.—(Special)—A brakeman named Gosselin was killed soon after midnight in a collision between two freight trains near this place. One train had taken the siding with the enveytion of the two ast cars, when the engine of the other train going in the opposite direction crashed into them. Gosseins remains were conveyed to Coatimook.
