FATAL ACCIDENT AT STOUFFVILLE. -The Fairlie engine recently introduced on the line of the Foronto and Nipissing Railway exploded her boiler at eleven o'clock on Saturday night while s. inding at Struffville station. Willi m Goddard, the driver, who had been removed from No. 10 train and was making his first trip in the new locomo. tive, was, along with the freman, John Carruthers, killed almost instantly, and another employee of the train was seriously injured The station house and freight shed were badly damaged, the root of the latter being tompletely blown off The bodies of the unfortanate men were brought to this city yesterday for interment. warrant for an inquest has as yet been lodged with the authorities.
