THE FIRST LOCOMOTIVE ON THE TRACK
—A new locomotive called the *Clifton*,
was placed on the Erie and Ontario Rail-
way, yesterday, and commenced travelling
on the road as far as the track is laid. It
worked admirably, and the road is very firm
and smooth. The completion of our railway
will doubtless be made by the time appointed,
viz: the 1st of June, next. Niagara will
not long remain set down in a corner by her-
self, but will, we trust, soon be in the very
front rank of the great West.
